Subdivision 3. Uses Allowed with Conditional Use Permit: **All non-residential dwellings**; Temporary Dwelling; Home Occupation-2; Agriculture; Public/Parks; Utilities (public & other; Stores(smaller); Offices (smaller); Service Shops (plumbing, electric, etc.); Gas Stations; Food/Bars/Convenience Stores; Gas/Garages; Bowling, Movies, etc. (Revised by Ord. 11-101, 04/07/11)
